***** NCA Dog Aggression Policy *****

"Any dog that in the opinion of the Event Committee, attacks a person or a dog at an NCA working event, resulting in an injury, and is believed by that Event Committee to present a hazard to persons or other dogs, shall be disqualified. When the dog is disqualified by the Event Committee pursuant to this section, a report shall be filed with the NCA Board. The disqualified dog may not again compete at any NCA working event, nor be on the grounds of an NCA working event unless and until, following application for reinstatement by the owner to the NCA Board, the owner receives official notification in writing from the NCA Board that the dog's eligibility has been reinstated."

General Information

Entry Fees and Policies: The entry fee is \$40.00 per dog per day. Post entry (same day) is \$20.00. Complete the enclosed NCA Water Test Entry Form for each dog entered. **Note that a copy of the dog's AKC registration form must be included.** The agreement must accompany the entry form. Make checks payable to the Bear Mountain Newfoundland Club. Send entries to, Oksana Jackim, 99 Tremont Street, Carver, MA 02330. Entries will be accepted by USPS mail only. Foreign entries must show a verifiable date of mailing. **Entries are limited to 6 WRDX and 25 maximum on Saturday, 28 dogs for Sunday.** The opening date for entries is **July 18, 2017, for NCA members. July 28, 2017, for non-members.** Entries postmarked prior to this date will be returned. The closing for entries is **August 17, 2017**, after which entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted. Late entries will be returned. Exhibitor numbers will be assigned by postmark. If the number of entries exceeds the limit, those dogs not yet having passed the division entered will have priority over re-qualifying dogs and alternates will be assigned by postmark.

Eligibility: This test is open only to purebred Newfoundland dogs (of either sex) that are at least 6 months of age on the date of the test. Dogs, which have not previously passed a water test in in Junior or Senior or WRDX divisions, have priority. Dogs, which have passed, may be entered for re-qualification judging if the entry limits have not been filled. Owners of dogs that pass the lower division after the closing date but prior to the test may choose to change their entry to the next division. Dogs passing the Junior Division at this test may be post entered in the Senior Division. Bitches in season will be tested after all other entrants have been judged each day. Other restrictions listed in the current NCA Water Test Regulations also apply.

Regulations: All entrants are responsible for knowing and understanding the NCA Water Test Regulations available from NCA Working Dog Publications. Dwight Gorsuch is the contact person for ordering any Water or Draft Publications in hard copy form. Mail checks to: Working Dog Publications, c/o Dwight Gorsuch, 6282 Burriss Road, Rock Hall, MD 21661 or on-line at the NCA site www.newfdogclub.org. BMNC is using regulations that were up dated March 2015.

Equipment: Each exhibitor is responsible for providing his or her own water test equipment, including a US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device and suitable foot protection. Please check the updated Water Test rules.

Test Site: The site consists of a large lake with sandy beach. The lake bottom is hard packed sand. The water clears rapidly (30-90 seconds) and the distance to swimming depth approximately 5 to 7 feet from shore. There is ample shade for all those attending; with restrooms approximately 50 yards from to the beach.

*Per the NCA regulations, the pre-swim may only be used to become familiar with the test waters and beached boat. No practicing of actual exercises! No food! Retrieving article only.

Withdrawing Entries and Refunds:

To withdraw an entry, the entrant must notify the test secretary by telephone, e-mail, or U.S. Mail. The secretary must confirm receipt of such notifications. The entrant will receive a full refund of the entry fee if the notification is received prior to the closing date for entries. After the closing date has passed, no refunds will be given, even if an alternate was tested in their place, with the exception of alternates that did not get into the test. In addition, an entrant with one dog in the test and another on the alternate list may not substitute one dog for the other. If the entrant must pull the entered dog, then the first dog on the alternate list will fill the opening.

Alternates and Refunds

If an entrant submits an entry to a draft or water test but is not assigned a place in the test, the test secretary must notify the entrant immediately after the closing date and give the entrant the option to be placed on the alternate list. If the entrant prefers not to be on the alternate list, he or she will receive a full refund. If the entrant chooses to stay on the alternate list and pulls their entry at a later date they will not receive a refund.

Once the closing date listed in the premium has passed, if an entrant notifies the secretary that they are withdrawing their entry or have passed at a previous test, all entrants on the alternate list must be notified that their ranks have changed. If a space does not become available for an alternate on or before the day of the test, the alternate will receive a full refund.

Example: If a test limit is 25 dogs and 25 dogs are tested, but none of the five dogs that were on an alternate list were tested, the five alternates would receive refunds after the test. If 20 original dogs and three alternates were tested, but two alternates did not attend the test, the handlers of those two alternates would not receive refunds because had they attended, they would have been tested. If an entrant has been assigned a spot in the test but their dog passes at a previous test, the handler must notify the test secretary by 6 pm the night before the test as to whether they will move their entry to another division (i.e., DD to TDD or DD to DDX), withdraw from the test, or requalify in the same division if the test is not full. If the test is full they have the option of being moved to the end of the alternate list to requalify.

Directions

To Test Site:

From West of the Hudson: Take I-87/N.Y. Thruway to Exit# 18 (New Paltz), turn right onto Route 299. Drive east on Rt.299 for approx.6 miles, Turn right on to Rt 9W and drive south 2.3 miles to the Mid Hudson Bridge (Rt 44-55). Cross bridge and follow Rt 55 to Dutcher Ave. (Pawling) Turn left on to Dutcher Ave. follow to end, turn right onto W. Main and then quick left before railroad tracks onto Charles Colman Blvd. Approx 1.5 miles to Lakeside Dr. Site is directly ahead.

From the East/West: Take I-84 West to NY Exit 20, take Rt 22 North to Corbin Rd., turn left on to Corbin Rd. and follow to Lakeside Drive.

From the South: Take Hutchinson River Pkwy North to I-684 north (to Brewster), take Rt 22 North to Corbin Rd., turn left on Corbin Rd., follow to Lakeside Drive.

From the test site to the Inn at Arbor Ridge:

Turn hard right onto Lakeside Dr; go 0.98 miles to Old Route 55; Bear right onto Old Route 55 (West); go 2.9 miles to RT-55; Continue on RT-55 for 1.7 miles to RT-216; Turn left onto RT-216; go 6.2 miles to RT-52; Bear right onto RT-52 (West); go 2.1 miles to RT-376; Turn right onto RT-376 (North) for 500 feet to 17 Route 376

From the Inn at Arbor Ridge to Daddy O's:

Go North on RT-376 for 2.0 miles; Turn right onto RT-82, approx. ¼ miles (immediately after bridge) turn left onto Turner St & entrance to Daddy O's is on left.
